ALL STUDENTS TO RETURN TO SCHOOL FULL TIME FROM WEEK 5 - MONDAY MAY 25.

Following the success of Phase 1 of the staggered return to school, the NSW Government and the NSW Department of Education have deemed it safe for all students to return to full time learning AT SCHOOL from Monday, May 25. Colyton High School students should report immediately to roll class, as normal, before attending period 1. There will be no whole school assemblies until further notice.

Students will commence on Week A of their timetable and attend their normal classes taught by their usual teachers. Work will be delivered through the usual variety of classroom-based methods. Learning packs are being phased out.

Students should bring in their current work pack (Pack 2) on Monday May 25 or as instructed by their teachers.

Colyton High School will continue to strictly apply the recommended health and safety practises as per Department of Health and Department of Education advice. This includes regular washing and sanitizing of hands; physical distancing (avoiding direct contact with others or shared objects) and safer sneezing and coughing practices (into the elbow).

The school has good supplies of soaps and sanitizers, as well as other cleaning products, at this time and supply chains have improved access to further supplies as needed. Every classroom has sanitizer supplies and soap is freely available in student toilets and staffrooms across the school. There are enhanced and more regular cleaning practices throughout the day across the school and in classrooms. Students are encouraged to report any health or cleanliness issues of concern to a teacher, so they may be promptly addressed.

Cooperation on these and other well publicised aspects of health and safety, will mean that we are all doing our best to continue to keep our school and its staff and students safe.

We will continue to communicate further details in a timely fashion and encourage you to stay informed through our usual communications and social media channels such as School Website, SENTRAL Student & Parent Portal, Facebook, Skoolbag and Instagram.
